Jerusalem: The Next 50 Years **RABBI MICHAEL S. FRIEDMAN, SENIOR RABBI**



In June of 1967, in response to military provocation and economic strangulation by its Arab neighbors, Israel launched a defensive war for its own survival. Though vastly outnumbered, the Israel Defense Forces achieved miraculous success, conquering the West Bank, Gaza Strip, Golan Heights and Sinai Peninsula in less than a week. This spring thus marks the 50th anniversary of Israel's momentous victory in the Six-Day War.

The triumph is as pivotal an event as any in the history of the Jewish people. Israel's victory greatly enlarged the territory of the State of Israel, providing a measure of security for the young nation. Israel's victory brought significant non-Jewish populations under Israeli control, the implications of which continue to shape the region. Most significantly, Israel's victory reunified our eternal capital, Jerusalem, once again giving Jews access to the Old City and the Kotel (Western Wall).

There is both deep pride and significant complexity present in this 50th anniversary.

Thus this anniversary is an opportunity for all of us. Starting with Passover and continuing through early June we will embark on a congregation-wide journey of learning and engagement entitled Jerusalem: The Next 50 Years.

We will take advantage of this anniversary to learn about and engage with Jerusalem in a range of modes across all age groups. Jerusalem will figure prominently in our worship. We will host guest teachers and lecturers who will teach us about Jerusalem past and present. Our early childhood and religious school students will embark on projects designed to teach them about Jerusalem.

Our holy city, Jerusalem, will be at the center of our consciousness this spring. We invite you to join us in learning, exploring, debating and imagining during the season of this 50th anniversary.

May Jerusalem's history enlighten us. May her majesty lift us. May her complexity challenge us. May her future inspire us.


