Director, CT Region, ADL

Since 2015, Steve Ginsburg has served as Executive Director of the Anti-Defamation League's (ADL) Connecticut Region. He is a leading voice in the fight against hate and bigotry. Steve leads ADL's efforts to monitor and expose extremist groups, educate about bias and bullying, and advocate for justice and civil rights. Steve directs ADL's work with law enforcement and community partners to prevent and respond to hate crimes, and to build bridges of understanding.

Steve came to ADL after serving as Principal at Mission Measurement – where he worked with philanthropists, corporations and nonprofits to measure and maximize their social impact. Steve served as Director of Development for ADL's Midwest Region, as Assistant General Counsel at Huron Consulting Group and as Chief Legal Counsel to the Office of the Governor of the State of Illinois. In the late 1990s, Steve also led the American Bar Association Rule of Law reform project in Sarajevo, Bosnia-Herzegovina. Steve practiced corporate transactional law at Katten Muchin Rosenman. Steve received his A.B. from Duke University and his J.D. from Georgetown University Law Center. Born in Highland Park, IL, Steve now resides in Westport, CT with his wife and their two sons.
